

East X South

S.M.A.R.T., Cevallos Lofts, and St. Philip's College Department of Fine Arts presents "East X South" an exhibition of work by St. Philip's College art students. Curated by Yvette and Andy Benavides and the SPC department faculty, "East X South" is on view Monday, March 1, 2019 through February 2020, at the Cevallos Lofts, 301 E. Cevallos St., San Antonio, Texas.

In response to the exhibition space of the Cevallos Lofts, "East X South" brings together a collective group of works that explore personal experiences. Individuals navigate these experiences by exploiting perspectival spaces, the figure, still-life, and the narrative through differing approaches to content, media, and technique.

The exhibition includes work by Yolanda Martinez who explores experimental processes using the organic form to weave figure and space into graphic entities of nature and abstraction; Donovan Sanchez is inspired by street art and graffiti to create his own interpretations of color and shape with intimate passages that describe spatial relationships; Alejandra Rendon Baena's work speaks to the surrealist narrative using collage to composite personal imagery; while Madison Cuenca uses her attention to detail to bring focus to her abstraction and sense of exploration.
